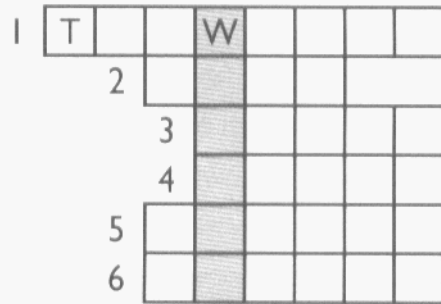


WISDOM
